Major firing and detonation activity schedule at Base Valcartier for September 2017

Please find below the September schedule for the major fire training activities that will take place mainly in the north areas of Base Valcartier, more specifically north of the Jacques-Cartier River.

- From September 11 to 15, the [5^e Régiment d'artillerie légère du Canada](#) will participate to Exercice PIÈCES AGUERRIES. The goal of this training exercise is to validate and maintain the skills of high readiness personnel. During the exercise, 155 mm and 81 mm ammunition will be used. Please note the firing will take place at day and also at night, between 6 a.m. and 1 a.m.
- From September 23 to 24, the [2nd Field Regiment, RCA](#) will participate in a 105 mm and 81 mm artillery fire training exercise. To achieve the training objectives, the firing will start at 7 a.m. and will stop at around 11 p.m.
- From September 29 to October 1st, the [62nd Field Artillery Regiment](#) will participate in a 105 mm and 81 mm artillery fire training exercise. To achieve the training objectives, the firing will start at 7 a.m. and will stop at around 11 p.m.

We are aware of the inconveniences that they may cause, particularly as a result of the noise generated by firing and detonation, which can be compounded by cloudy and cold weather. We would like to thank the public for their ongoing cooperation.
