

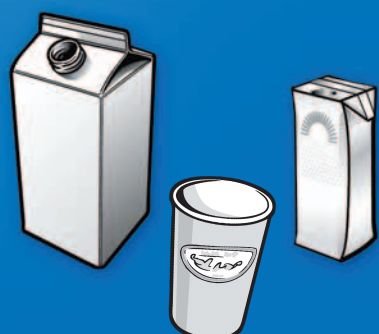
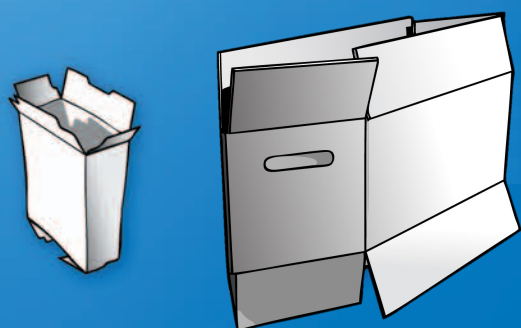
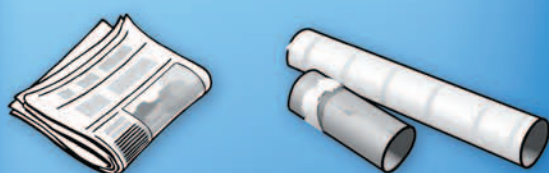


Chart for accepted materials in recycling bins/dumpsters

- ▶ Please separate the different types of materials;
- ▶ Empty all containers and flatten all boxes.

PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- ▶ newspapers, flyers, magazines
- ▶ paper sheets, envelopes and bags
- ▶ books, phonebooks
- ▶ cardboard rolls
- ▶ cardboard boxes (flattened)
- ▶ egg cartons
- ▶ milk and juice cartons
- ▶ aseptic containers (Tetra Pak™ type)
- ▶ waxed cardboard cups



PLASTIC CONTAINERS

- ▶ bottles, containers and wrappings featuring one of these symbols:



- ▶ styrofoam containers and plastic utensils
- ▶ caps and lids
- ▶ clean bags and plastic wrappers (into a knotted bag)
- ▶ empty motor oil or antifreeze containers (with cap on)



GLASS CONTAINERS

- ▶ bottles and jars, regardless of colour



METAL CONTAINERS

- ▶ aluminum foil and containers
- ▶ aluminum bottles and cans
- ▶ tin cans
- ▶ caps and lids
- ▶ empty, dry paint cans (lid off)
