NOTICE TO SHANNON RESIDENTS

REPAIRS TO DND FENCED PERIMETER BORDERING THE TOWN OF SHANNON

September 21, 2022 – 2nd Canadian Division Support Base Valcartier (Base Valcartier)

Shannon residents whose property borders the Department of National Defence's (DND) fenced perimeter may see workers busy repairing or replacing portions of the fence in the weeks to come. As detailed in a separate [Public Service Announcement published in March 2022](#) (French), the locations of particular concern are located along the fenced perimeter of the Department of National Defence (DND) along Jacques-Cartier Boulevard, as well as des Mélèzes and des Cerisiers streets.

Let's recall that fines can be issued to those who infringe the various related Defence regulations (referenced below). We obviously wish to avoid resorting to this punitive measure. This is why military police will carry out random awareness patrols along the targeted route over the next few weeks.

Shannon and Base Valcartier have had strong ties for a long time, especially since many members of the military community are also Shannon residents. Everyone's safety is of paramount importance. We therefore call on our neighbours to comply with the indications prohibiting access to DND property.
